


The TX Ranch has grown from a turn-of-the-century homestead to over 35,000 acres straddling the Wyoming-Montana border. It is located on privately owned, open-range country stretching between the gorgeous Pryor Mountains on down to the Big Horn Canyon and its breathtaking overlook. It has been owned by the Tillett family since 1898, and we respectfully take pride in operating the ranch in the same manner our great-grandfolks did because we value their ways.

All riding, cattle and horse-related activities are a necessary part of our daily lives. More than 1,200 head of cattle and over 100 head of horses provide plenty of riding and work opportunities every day of the week



for all riding levels. You are welcome to participate with as much or as little as you choose. Everything from trailing a herd, roping calves, branding, doctoring, wrangling horses—whatever it may be, our cowboys are happy to help show how it's done. You are also welcome to ride on your own for as long as you wish.

Our cow camps are set up in an outdoor camping-style atmosphere. Canvas wall tents are provided and include your cot with a good mattress pad and a wood burning stove if desired, with wood provided in camp. Setup in camp includes a wash table with wash basins, a small wooden shower house, and an outhouse facility. Fresh water tanks are provided near the cabin area for your personal use and for drinking. Excellent home-cooked meals are prepared in a log cabin at each camp. Evenings are often spent around the campfire under myriad stars and listening to coyotes howling in the distance.
